Band Alumni from nine decades attend weekend of Centennial Events

To cap off the 100 year celebration of Pitt Band, a series of alumni and student events were held the weekend of April 13-15, 2012, in Oakland and surrounding areas. Although in the midst of security challenges at Pitt, the weekend events went off without a hitch as alumni, students, and families were able to enjoy a fabulous weekend of socializing, sharing stories, and learning about the Pitt Band's 100 year history.

The weekend kicked off on April 13th with a gathering at the Library bar & restaurant in the South Side with over 100 alumni in attendance. The following day began with historic tours of Oakland, a student-sponsored exhibit on the expansive Pitt Band history, a student-sponsored Instrument Safari that gave participants a fun interactive musical display; and a silent auction and raffle with a wide variety of unique Pitt memorabilia, tickets, autographed items, and other fun takeaways. The Centennial Banquet took place later that evening at the Alumni Hall Connolley Ballroom. The program was chock-full of notable speakers, including guests Chancellor Mark A. Nordenberg, Athletic Director Steve Pederson, and former directors Don Hower and O'Neill Sanford. Former alumni, who marched as early as the 1930's, also shared moving stories from their times in the marching band. The night ended with a video montage of the band's history and the announcement of a proclamation from the City Council declaring April 14, 2012 as "Pitt Band Centennial Day," in the City of Pittsburgh.

The main event on April 15th was the annual Spring Gala symphonic band concert, held this year at Soldiers & Sailors Hall in honor of the special weekend. The concert included appearances by guest conductors Don Hower, former band director, and Joe Jordano, Pitt's baseball team coach. In addition, there were further events held throughout the weekend by the students of the four band organizations for their alumni.

PBAC thanks all who attended and helped with these monumental events commemorating the centennial anniversary of Pitt Band.
