The Pitt Band's Panther:

In 2008, the Student Government Board bought 10 panther statues that would be decorated by different student organizations. The Pitt Band was one of 26 applicants, and was awarded a statue. With the help of the Pitt Band's Greek organizations they painted the statue, which today represents the Pitt Band in the lobby of the Petersen Event Center.

The problem is that every year we need to reapply to keep the statue, and there is no guarantee that we will continue to keep it. For this reason, we would like to raise money to buy the panther statue from SGB, at a cost of \$4000. This will allow them to replace our statue so that we can keep ours. We need to raise the full amount by the end of 2009, and would appreciate donations. We will include the names of donors who give more than \$100 on a plaque to be attached to the base of the statue.
