### Homecoming-Alumni Band Weekend 2000—September 15-16

Plans are underway for a weekend full of events for the 2000 Homecoming Celebration when Pitt plays host to Penn State at Three Rivers Stadium.

It has been many years since PBAC held Alumni Band weekend on Homecoming, but this year's circumstances are unique. Unfortunately, the logistics involved with Pitt's games being played at Three Rivers Stadium caused us to opt for not marching a halftime show this year. The good news is that you can just plan to attend and have fun...no work will be involved!

Rather than a formal Homecoming Banquet, we will have an informal event at the Pitt Club on Friday evening (where last year's Friday evening event was held). This will include hearty hors d'oeuvres and a cash bar from 6:30 to 9 p.m. After the 9 p.m. fireworks, the Pitt Alumni Association will host an Alumni Piano Bar at the Pitt Club that is open to all Pitt alumni.

For the Pitt-Penn State game on Saturday, PBAC has purchased a block of 100 seats for the game. These will be sold to band alumni on a first come, first served basis. We may be able to purchase additional seats, but cannot guarantee availability. The cost of tickets is \$35 each and tickets are nonrefundable. They will be distributed at the PBAC event on Friday evening, or will be placed at the Will Call window. No tickets will be mailed.

#### Pitt Golden Girls Win Championships

In July, the Pitt Golden Girls traveled to Notre Dame to compete in the 35th American Youth on Parade World Open Championships. Sanctioned by the National Baton Twirling Association International, this competition is also known as the World Series of Twirling.

The team from the University of Pittsburgh was named **2000 Grand National College Halftime Show Team Champions**. In addition, they competed in the Senior Dance Twirl category against 33 teams from around the world and placed first ahead of teams from the University of Florida and University of Nebraska.
