New, Permanent Home for Our Pitt Band

On January 18, 2005, "Quest for Excellence – The Campaign for Pitt Athletics" was announced by the Pitt Athletic Department. The goal is to raise \$45 million over the next three years through increased support of the Panther Club Athletic Scholarship Fund (\$15 million) as well as for Olympic sport facility enhancements and endowment (\$30 million). A successful campaign will allow Pitt to level the playing field for 15 of 19 programs currently competing with less than the NCAA maximum allowable number of scholarships. It will also allow the building of new facilities for four programs competing without permanent homes, i.e. men's and women's soccer and men's and women's track and field. Included in the program is the building of a new, permanent home for our Pitt Band.

The Emmaline D. Barco Band Complex

Improvements from the current, temporary facility include:

- Permanent versus temporary home, including rehearsal area and administrative offices;
- On-site storage and adequate indoor practice space;
- State-of-the-art acoustics, playing surface and equipment;
- Potential site for concerts, camps and special events;
- A facility that will push the band programs to further excellence and will be a source of pride for the 250+ students who participate each year, the University and the athletes who represent us.

The Quest for Excellence Campaign is under the guidance of Mike Pratapas, Senior Associate Athletic Director and his staff. Your Pitt Band Alumni Council is fully cooperating with Mike and his staff to make it happen! Our current PBAC officers – Tony Roscoe, Bonnie Alspach, Ryan Minster, Becky and Dave Yuhas – will be fully involved. In addition we have formed an alumni advisory team to assist in the success of the campaign. This team includes:

The Cost of Communication

Communication with our alumni is one of the top priorities for the Pitt Band Alumni Council. Otherwise you would not know about Alumni Band Day or the many ways that we continue to support the band program. To this end, we continue to maintain an email distribution list (pittbandalumni@yahoogroups.com), an updated website (www.pbac.net) and regular mailings and newsletters. The email group is free, and both the website hosting and maintenance are donated by alumni. (Thanks to Mark Matty and Dave Yuhas.)

However, the newsletter is a major cost item that will only increase with time. Our annual income from dues-paying members is approximately \$3000. A typical mailing that goes out to all 2200 of our alumni and friends costs nearly half of that amount alone.

In an effort to reduce costs so that we can continue providing you and the band program the appropriate support, the PBAC is looking for ways to communicate through electronic media. We understand that many of you may not have email addresses or online access to our website, so we will not eliminate mailings entirely. However, we encourage everyone to sign up for electronic distribution, via email, of our future newsletters. Keep an eye open in your email inboxes and visit our website on a regular basis for more information.

2004 PBAC Scholarship

Each year the PBAC awards a \$3000.00 tuition scholarship to a band person entering his or her sophomore year. The award – \$1000.00 per year – is matched by the University. In addition, two Frank Bolden Memorial Book Grants of \$150 are given each year to runners-up for the tuition scholarship. The winners were announced at band camp in August.

The 2004 winner of the tuition scholarship is Brian Nicholas. Brian marched in the bass section during the football season and also played bass in the symphonic band. He hails from Irwin, Pennsylvania, and is majoring in electrical engineering.

Book certificate awards went to Kevin Newak Daniel Boyd (trumpet) and Stephanie Peischl (colorguard). Kevin and Stephanie had fine freshman years in the VMB and continue their commitment, teamwork and pride in our band programs.

On behalf of our students, we thank all band alumni who make yearly contributions to the PBAC scholarship fund.
